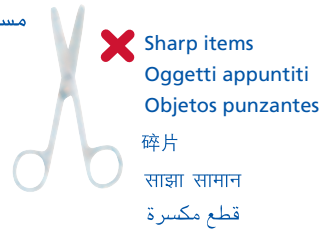

# NEW Security Rules

## Items Not Permitted ❌

### Any Liquids and Gels:

- Any drinks in cans, bottles, plastic containers, cardboard cartons, etc.

### Liquid Cosmetics and Toiletries

All cosmetics and toiletries in liquid/gel form, for example:

- Soaps
- Fragrance and perfume
- Creams
- Liquid foundations and lip gloss
- Mascara
- Toothpaste
- All products in pressurised contain e.g. hairspray and shaving foam/gel
- Deodorants
- Sun tanning products
- Bottles of contact lens solution

### Food

Any liquid-based food products in packets, tubes, plastic or tin containers, for example:

- Pasta or any other foodstuffs in sauces, gravies or other liquids
- Jams and syrups
- Sauces
- Pastes
- Yoghurts
- Soups (carton or otherwise)
- Stews or curry

### Writing Implements

- Ink and spare cartridges for fountain pens

### Baby Milk/Food

- Are permitted if tasted in the presence of a security officer and if quantity is limited for use during flight

### Other Items

- Sharp items
- Cigarette lighters
- Non-safety matches

## Items Permitted ✅

### Drinks

- Empty containers such as flasks and mugs

### Cosmetics and Toiletries

- Sanitary towels and tampons
- Talcum Powder
- Non-consumable cosmetics and toiletries, eg:
  - Combs
  - Cotton Wool
  - Fully disposable razors/razor cartridges
  - Toothbrushes
  - Disposable contact lenses in sealed packaging, sufficient for flight (ie one or two pairs)
  - Non-disposable contact lenses in carrier with small amount of solution (but not bottles of solution)

### Food

- Sandwiches
- Crisps
- Fruit
- Vegetables
- Other solid foods

### Writing implements

- Biro, rollerball pens, gel pens
- Fountain pens with single, open cartridge in use (but no refills)
- Pencils

### Baby Milk/Food

- Empty containers such as empty bottles, beakers or flasks
- Baby milk (if tasted by the passenger)
- Sterilised baby water (if tasted by the passenger)
- Baby juice (if tasted by the passenger)
- Baby food in liquid, gel or paste form (if tasted by the passenger)
- Baby food powder (need not be tasted)

### Smoking Materials

- Cigarettes
- Cigars
- Rolling tobacco
- Cigarette papers
- A single book or box of safety matches

# NEW Security Rules

## What to do with your essential, prescription medicine

Liquid, cream or gel

Solid (powder up to 50g or tablet)

Over 50ml

Under 50ml

The liquid is NOT permitted in the cabin and you will need to refer back to your airline

You will be asked to taste the liquid in order to verify that it is genuine

The powder or tablets are permitted in the cabin with no further investigation or verification required

You are unable (for whatever reason) to taste the liquid

You taste the liquid in order to verify it as genuine

You will be referred back to the airline who will accompany you to an airport pharmacist

The liquid is permitted in the cabin with no further investigation or verification required

The pharmacist rejects the liquid

The pharmacist verifies the liquid

The liquid is NOT permitted in the cabin

The liquid is permitted in the cabin

### Your liquid non-prescription medicine

Child's non-prescription liquid medicines (no more than 50ml), such as Calpol, are permitted, but you'll need to taste them to verify.

Adults' non-prescription liquid medicines are not permitted

### Your solid non-prescription medicine

All other solid non-prescription medicines are permitted.
