**Proposed Heathrow Airtrack Order**

**NOTICE OF FURTHER ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION**

---

On 24 July 2009 Heathrow Airport Limited of 130 Wilton Road London SW1V 1LQ, applied to the Secretary of State for Transport under section 6 of the Transport and Works Act 1992, for an Order relating to a new railway providing direct access to Heathrow Airport from south-west London, Surrey and Berkshire.

The Order makes provision for the re-construction of the existing Staines station and the construction, maintenance and operation of the following works: a new chord line in Staines town centre linking the existing railway line from Staines to Windsor with the lines to Guildford and Reading; a new railway across Staines Moor and Stanwell Moor to Heathrow Terminal 5, including a tunnel between Stanwell Moor and Terminal 5; ancillary works to facilitate the construction of the railways; and provision of a depot for the maintenance and stabling of trains on the former railway marshalling yard at Feltham.

The Order includes provisions for -

1. the construction and maintenance of the proposed works, including provisions relating to streets, including powers to alter the layout of streets and powers to stop up streets permanently and temporarily; replacement and closure of pedestrian level crossings; creation of public paths; protective works to buildings, roads and apparatus; and powers to survey and investigate land;
2. the compulsory acquisition of land for the proposed works and ancillary purposes, including worksites, landscaping and exchange land; the imposition of restrictive covenants or acquisition of easements or other rights only in or over specified land; provisions for the temporary use of land in connection with the construction or maintenance of the works; and the extinction or suspension of private rights of way;
3. the construction of works and the compulsory acquisition and use of land within Staines Common and adjoining open space and the provision and vesting of exchange land; and
4. the lopping of overhanging trees; authority for statutory undertakers to drive over specified footpaths or bridleways; powers to operate and use the railway to enter into agreements with Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and to transfer the undertaking with the consent of the Secretary of State; the disapplication of provisions of the Water Resources Act 1991; the prevention of trespass and the obstruction of the of the works.

The application is subject to an environmental impact assessment and further information is available in relation to the environmental statement which was provided with the application.

In addition the applicants are modifying or correcting their proposals for alteration of public rights of way as follows -

- The course of Public Footpath No. 17 shown on the order plans and rights of way map proposed to be stopped up has been corrected;
- The course of Public Footpath No. 16 shown on the order plans and rights of way map proposed to be stopped up has been corrected; and
- New footpaths are proposed linking Public Footpath 19 with the proposed new footpath to be provided between points C4, F4 and E4 shown on the order plans and rights of way map.

A copy of the further environmental information and the replacement sheets of the Order plans and rights of way maps may be inspected free of charge from 12 May until 23 June 2010 at the places and times set out in the schedule below.
